Call for Candidates to Fill Board Positions


With the Annual Election of our Board of Directors in February 2026, we are currently accepting nominations to fill four two-year vacancies.

Form Due By 9/12/25

Homeowners were mailed an Annual Owners Disclosure Form on August 1st and it is due back by September 12th..

This form lets the Association know how each homeowner would like to receive their quarterly billing statements, annual notices, and the Green Valley Gazette, whether by mail, email or both. It also updates their phone number(s) and email address(es) with the Association office.

This form allows homeowners to opt out of information placed on the membership list, should one be requested for legitimate reasons, by another homeowner.

If you have not returned your form, please send it in today! If you can't locate it, please stop by the office and we will gladly get you another.

Facility Rentals

Adult Clubhouse:

17250 Los Jardines West, maximum occupancy is 63 Family Clubhouse:

10739 Los Jardines West, maximum occupancy is 58 Clubhouse Rental Fees:

\$40 per hour, minimum four hours (Must include set-up & clean-up time)

\$500 - security deposit. (Separate check that we hold)

Green Valley has two, nice, air conditioned clubhouses that are available to homeowners and authorized tenants to rent. The clubhouses come with a full kitchen, round & rectangular tables and chairs. Rentals must be made at least 10 working days prior to date desired, no exceptions.

Rentals must be cleaned up and vacated by midnight on Friday and Saturday and 11:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday. Live bands are not allowed. Amplified music must be kept indoors with the windows and doors closed. The Adult Clubhouse is handicapped accessible.

In addition, you must also be able to provide a certificate of liability insurance, minimum \$500,000 coverage per occurrence, from your homeowners insurance company. It is required that it names the Green Valley Homeowners' Recreation Association as additional insured for the date(s) of your rental. This must be turned in to the Association office no later than ten (10) days before the Use Date. Green Valley can no longer just be listed as the certificate holder, but must be listed as additional insured.

Feel free to stop by the Association office during office hours to check the reservation book or pick up a key to take a look at the clubhouses. We can check the book and hold a date for you for a few days.

The Family Clubhouse is located in the courtyard directly across from the Association office. The Adult Clubhouse is located north of Slater, next to the Adult Pool.

The use of the pool is not included in the rental and pool parties are not allowed. The use of inflatables or live animal attractions is not allowed.

Mail Slot

We have a mail slot on the west wall of the Association office available to you 24 hours a day where you can drop off your payment, registration, keys, lost & found items, etc.

Street Sweeping Parking

The city sweeps our public streets on the **second and fourth Thursdays of each month**. They will ticket cars parked on the street as the street sweeper passes. Please do not park in the clubhouse parking lots on street sweeping days. The parking lot is for facility users and staff only. Any cars in the lot after 8:00 a.m. may be towed at owner's expense.

Exterior Walls

Exterior walls that are facing streets must be replaced with like-for-like - Fountain Valley Civil Code Section 21.18.070. Since all perimeter walls are block, they must be replaced as such. Walls are painted Dunn Edwards Phoenix Villa DEW324.

Recycle Used Batteries

Recycle your used batteries at the Association Office. We will take them to city hall or the hazardous waste center when the container is full. (No hazardous waste collected.)



Sign Up for Auto Pay of Your **Quarterly Association Assessments**

Green Valley has 1,048 homes and the billing of the quarterly assessments is divided into three different billing groups. Group 1 begins their billing cycle in January, Group 2 in February and Group 3 in March. Bills are sent out on the first of the month, and payment is due by the last day of that first month of the quarter.

If you are interested in signing up for auto pay, stop by the Association office with a voided check and complete the ACH Debit Agreement form. Payments are debited on the 15th of the month that you are billed. If the selected date falls on a weekend or legal bank holiday, the debit will take effect on the next business day.

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CHECKLIS I. Renew, Refresh and Reorganize for a

Rejuvenated Home this Spring

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Important Rules for All E-Bike Riders

Follow Traffic Laws: E-bike riders in California have the same rights and responsibilities as traditional bicyclists and must follow all traffic laws, including obeying stop signs, traffic signals, and posted speed limits.

Ride Right: Cyclists should ride to the right side of the road as practicable. If riding slower than traffic, using the bike lane is recommended.

Yield to Pedestrians: Always yield to pedestrians in crosswalks and on sidewalks where riding is permitted.

Lights and Reflectors: Proper reflective and lighting equipment is essential for night riding. Passengers: Carrying passengers is generally only allowed if the e-bike has a designated seat, and passengers under 18 must wear a helmet. Class 3 e-bikes specifically prohibit carrying passengers.

Parental Responsibilities

Parents bear a significant responsibility in ensuring their children ride e-bikes safely and responsibly.

Training and Supervision: Parents should educate their children on traffic laws, safe riding techniques, and the importance of helmets. Ongoing supervision and assessment are crucial, including riding with children, regularly checking equipment, and refreshing safety training.

Set Boundaries and Expectations: Establish clear rules regarding where and when children can ride, including restrictions on traffic lanes, reckless behavior, and night riding.

E-bike Maintenance: Parents should regularly inspect their child's e-bike to ensure brakes, tires, lights, and other safety features are in proper working order.

Lead by Example: Demonstrate safe riding habits by following traffic laws and exercising caution on the road.

Understand Legal Liability: Parents in California can be held legally, financially, and morally responsible for the actions of their children while riding e-bikes, particularly in cases involving

willful misconduct or negligence. This can include situations where a child causes injury to a pedestrian or another rider. Homeowner's or renter's insurance may provide some coverage for such incidents, but understanding the limitations and potential exclusions is essential.

Pool Info

Pool parties and private lessons are not allowed



Heaters: The pools are heated to 84 degrees.

<u>Keys:</u> The pool keys are the same this year. If you lost your keys or need to purchase an additional one, they are \$100 each and must be purchased by the homeowner of record. Please bring your ID with you to the Association office.

<u>Lifeguards</u>: No Lifeguards on Duty until May 2026. Anyone under the age of 14 must have a parent or guardian with them at all times.

Small Children: Any child not potty trained should wear a swim diaper. To assist in the safety of all children, we ask that an adult stay within 5' of small children in the pool at all times. We also require that an adult be within 10' of any child that is not a strong swimmer or able to swim across the pool in the deep end.

Aqua Tone: Water exercise classes are held Tuesday, Thursdays & Saturdays at 10:00 a.m. at the North Pool. The pool and pool deck are closed during class.

<u>Stroke Clinic:</u> Clinic will be held Monday through Friday, September 8 to October 30 from 3:30 to 7:15 p.m. at the North Pool. The pool and deck are closed during practice.

POOL RULES Pool Hours 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Pool Hours 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. No Pool Parties or Private Lessons Allowed

- 1. Children under the age of 14 are not allowed in the pool gate without an adult or lifeguard. Children 14-17 years must wear a green swim tag to swim without an adult or lifeguard. Swim tags may be obtained in the Green Valley office and are for residents only.
 - 2. Gates must always be kept closed and locked.
- 3. No more than 4 guests per Green Valley adult resident. No pool parties or large groups allowed.
- 4. Any damage to the pool or pool area will be the responsibility of the homeowner.
- 5. Showers are for rinsing off only. No soap or shampoo allowed.
- 6. No alcohol, smoking, illegal drugs, glass or breakable containers allowed. Barbecues must be outside the gated deck area
- 7. While on duty, the lifeguards are the designated authority. Anyone violating pool rules will be asked to leave. Parents are responsible for their children/guests, regardless if there is a lifeguard on duty. Lifeguards will conduct a mandatory 5-minute safety break each hour. All individuals must exit the pool at that time. No exceptions.
- 8. To assist in the safety of all children, an adult must stay within 5' of small children in the pool at all times. An adult must be within 10' of any child that is not able to swim across the pool.
- 9. All children under the age of 4 (toilet trained or not) must wear a swim diaper or tight fitting plastic pants.
- 10. No toys or flotations allowed. Only those used to assist in swimming safely are permitted.
- 11. Any person having an obvious communicable disease, skin eruption, cut, sore or lesion, eye, ear, nose or throat infection, is not permitted from using the pool.
- 12. In the event of thunder or lightning, the pool will be closed immediately. It will reopen 30 minutes after the last incident.
- 13. No running, horseplay or pushing of others in the pool. Abusive/foul language or lewd conduct is prohibited.
 - 14. No bicycles or skateboards allowed in the pool deck area.
- 15. In accordance with Health Department regulations, no pets are allowed in the pool area.
 - 16. Proper swimming attire is required.
- 17. All persons swim at their own risk and should not swim alone when no lifeguard is on duty.
- 18. The Adult Pool is for those 21 years of age and older only. No infants or children.


