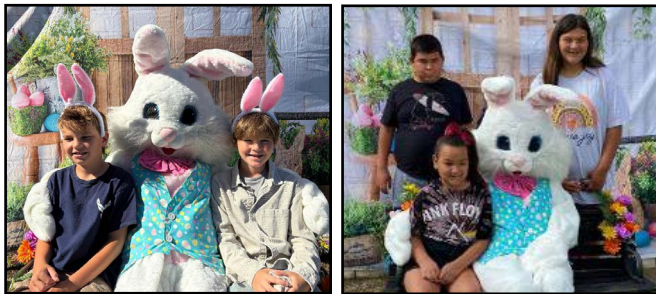

Street Sweeping Parking

The city sweeps our public streets on the **second and fourth Thursdays of each month.** They will ticket cars parked on the street as the street sweeper passes. Please do not park in the clubhouse parking lots on street sweeping days. The parking lot is for facility users and staff only. Any cars in the lot after 8:00 a.m. may be towed at owner's expense.

Exterior Walls

Exterior walls that are facing streets must be replaced with like-for-like - Fountain Valley Civil Code Section 21.18.070. Since all perimeter walls are block, they must be replaced as such. Walls are painted Dunn Edwards Phoenix Villa DEW324.

Recycle Used Batteries

Recycle your used batteries at the Association Office. We will take them to city hall or the hazardous waste center when the container is full. (No hazardous waste collected.)

Adult Clubhouse:

17250 Los Jardines West, maximum occupancy is 63

Family Clubhouse:

10739 Los Jardines West, maximum occupancy is 58

Clubhouse Rental Fees:

\$40 per hour, minimum four hours (Must include set-up & clean-up time)

\$500 - security deposit. (Separate check that we hold)

Green Valley has two, nice, air conditioned clubhouses that are available to homeowners and authorized tenants to rent. The clubhouses come with a full kitchen, round & rectangular tables and chairs. Rentals must be made at least 10 working days prior to date desired, no exceptions.

Rentals must be cleaned up and vacated by midnight on Friday and Saturday and 11:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday. Live bands are not allowed. Amplified music must be kept indoors with the windows and doors closed. The Adult Clubhouse is handicapped accessible.

In addition, you must also be able to provide a certificate of liability insurance, minimum \$500,000 coverage per occurrence, from your homeowners insurance company. It is required that it names the Green Valley Homeowners' Recreation Association as additional insured for the date(s) of your rental. This must be turned in to the Association office no later than ten (10) days before the Use Date. Green Valley can no longer just be listed as the certificate holder, but must be listed as additional insured.

Feel free to stop by the Association office during office hours to check the reservation book or pick up a key to take a look at the clubhouses. We can check the book and hold a date for you for a few days.

The Family Clubhouse is located in the courtyard directly across from the Association office. The Adult Clubhouse is located north of Slater, next to the Adult Pool.

The use of the pool is not included in the rental and pool parties are not allowed. The use of inflatables or live animal attractions is not allowed.

Pool Info

Pool parties and private lessons are not allowed.

Heaters: The pools are heated to 84 degrees. All three pools are heated!

Lifeguards: They will begin May 23rd. Anyone under the age of 14 years must have adult supervision.

Small Children: Any child not potty trained should wear a swim diaper. To assist in the safety of all children, we ask that an adult stay within 5' of small children in the pool at all times. We also require that an adult be within 10' of any child that is not a strong swimmer or able to swim across the pool in the deep end.

Aqua Tone: Water exercise classes are held three times per week at 10:00 a.m. at the North Pool. The pool and pool deck are closed during class.

Swim Team: Practices began March 30th through July 17th from 3:30 to 7:15 p.m. at the North Pool. The pool and deck are closed during practice. There are four Saturday home meets

Summer Swim Lessons: Lessons are held at the South Pool June 8 through August 14 from 9:00am to 12:00 p.m. and 5:00 to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

North Pool Water Change



The North Pool underwent a water change and maintenance at the beginning of April. Changing out the water every few years helps to remove the calcium build-up in the water that clogs the pumps and filters. It also allows for necessary maintenance to be done on the pool such as securing loose coping stones, checking the condition of the plaster, securing any loose tiles, etc. The pool was opened earlier than expected and ready for summer!

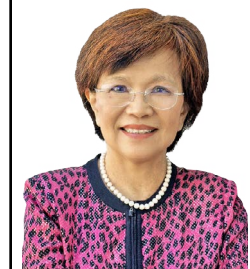

Playground Gets New Rings



The tot lot located on the south side of Slater, near El Toro, had one of the rings missing as the hardware attaching the ring was rusted. All of the rings and their hardware have been replaced.

The Board also approved to replace a couple of the decks and other rusting hardware to extend the life of the play structure.

Drains Approved; Areas Rototilled & Seeded

The Board of Directors approved to add a few drains in the park just south of Slater to help with the water that doesn't drain well after the rains. The ground in this area is so compacted over the years that the water sits on top. After the drains are installed, the area will be rototilled, soil amendments added and seeded.

Please read the Class Level Information to find the best American Red Cross Certified Class for your child.

The first day of class, students will be tested to make sure they are in the proper level.

**** Evening lessons are for Green Valley residents only. Nonresidents may register for morning lessons.**

*** CLASS LEVEL 1: INTRODUCTION TO WATER SKILLS - 3 1/2 to 5 years** - children with little or no swim experience. Helps the student feel comfortable in the water: *Enter and exit water safely; *Open eyes under water, pick up submerged object; *Swim on front and back using arm and leg actions; *Submerge mouth, nose and eyes; *Float on front and back; *Follow basic water safety rules; *Exhale water underwater through mouth and nose; *Explore arm and hand movements. Minimum age 3 1/2 years and able to stay in the class without a parent in the water.

*** CLASS LEVEL 2: FUNDAMENTAL AQUATIC SKILLS** - Students are introduced to front & back crawl - Gives students success with fundamental skills: *Enter water by stepping or jumping from the side; *Open eyes underwater, pick up submerged object; *Roll over from front to back, back to front; *Swim on front and back using combined strokes; *Float on front and back; *Swim on side; *Tread water using arm and leg motions; *Submerge entire head; *Perform front and back glide.

*** CLASS LEVEL 3 - STROKE DEVELOPMENT** (Shallow/Deep end of the pool) Students introduced to butterfly - Builds on the skills in Level 2 through additional guided practice: *Jump into deep water from the side; *Bob with head fully submerged; *Perform survival float; *Change from horizontal to vertical position on front and back; *Dive from kneeling or standing position; *Use rotary breathing in horizontal position; *Perform front and back crawl; *Submerge and retrieve object; *Perform front and back glide; *Butterfly - kick and body motion

*** CLASS LEVEL 4 - STROKE IMPROVEMENT** (Deep end of the pool) Students introduced to breast stroke & back stroke - Develop confidence in the skills learned and improves other aquatic skills: *Perform shallow dive or dive from stride position; *Perform open turns on front and back using any stroke; *Perform front and back crawl; *Perform elementary back stroke; *Perform breast stroke; *Swim on side using scissor-like kick; *Butterfly; *Swim underwater; *Tread water using sculling arm motions and kick.

*** CLASS LEVEL 5 - STROKE REFINEMENT** (Deep end of the pool) Students enhance four stroke and work on flip turns - Provide further coordination and refinement of strokes: *Tread water with two different kicks; *Standing dive; *Tuck and surface dive; *Backstroke flip turn; *Breaststroke; *Shallow dive, glide two body lengths and begin any front stroke; *Pike surface dive; *Front and back crawl; *Elementary backstroke; *Front flip turn; *Butterfly; *Side stroke

*** CLASS LEVEL 6 - SWIMMING AND SKILL PROFICIENCY** (Deep end of the pool) Students are swimming laps - Provide further coordination and refinement of the four basic strokes; *Be able to swim the strokes at least 50 yards; *Work on developing flip turns, breathing, technique and dives. For the most advanced swimmers.

*Swimmers are not allowed to enter the pool before their class time and must vacate the pool at the end of their lesson.

Registration Info:

* Registration is in-person, on a first come, first serve basis in the Association office. The office is located at 10739 Los Jardines West, Fountain Valley. Office hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Green Valley residents can begin registering on May 12th. Nonresidents can register beginning June 2nd.

* Walk-in registration only. No saving a spot for anyone in line. No phone-in or mail-in registration accepted. Payment due at time of registration. No refunds.

* Proof of Green Valley residency is required. You must show proof of Green Valley residency to receive the Green Valley discount. Anyone in question will be asked to pay the nonresident rate and will not be permitted to register until June 2nd.

* For your convenience, you may pay by check, cash, Visa or MasterCard. There is a 3% credit card transaction fee.

Lessons Fees:

* **Green Valley Residents:** Register beginning May 12th -- **\$65/session; \$55/session, additional child, same family, same session**
(We will not be taking registration May 20th to 27th due to the Memorial Day Picnic.)

* **Nonresidents:** Register beginning June 2nd -- **\$80/session** (No discounts for additional swimmer in same family)

Class Information:

*Goggles are highly recommended. Class size is limited to four to eight students per instructor. Classes fill, so register early! Full payment due at registration. No refunds.

*Evening lessons are reserved for Green Valley residents only. Nonresidents can only register for the morning lessons.

*Parents must stay at the pool during lessons. Should the pool be closed at any time, the remaining lessons for the day will be moved to the North Pool, 10824 Los Jardines East. A sign will be posted on the pool gate.

*No refunds. If you miss a class, we do not offer make-ups or partial refunds.

*If it rains, we still hold lessons. We will only cancel if there is lightning.

*Street sweeping is the second and fourth Thursdays of each month in the morning. Park at your own risk.

*PLEASE DO NOT FEED YOUR CHILD 30 MINUTES BEFORE THE START OF CLASS to help cut down on pool closures due to vomit. (The family may be charged the \$150 cleaning fee.) In case of pool closure, the lessons will be moved to the North Pool (10824 Los Jardines East.) A note will be posted on the South Pool gate.

Pool Location & Information:

* All lessons will be held at the South Pool, 10739 Los Jardines West, Fountain Valley.

* The South Pool is open to Green Valley residents only during swim lessons. If anyone is interrupting the lessons, they will be asked to leave the pool deck area. Nonresidents may not free swim before, during or after lessons. Swimmers must vacate the pool at the end of their lesson.

* There are no lifeguards on duty during the morning lessons. A parent/guardian must accompany and supervise children under the age of 14 years at all times. Please be at the pool to pick up your child immediately at the end of class. There is a ten minute break between classes when we clear the pool of all swimmers.

* Please obey the pool rules listed on the pool deck fence. Keep the gates closed and locked at all times!

* All children under the age of 4, potty trained or not, must wear a swim diaper or rubber pants in the pool at all times. Please take your child to the restroom before class begins to help cut down on pool closures due to defecation. The family may be charged the \$150 pool cleaning fee.

* No private lessons allowed.



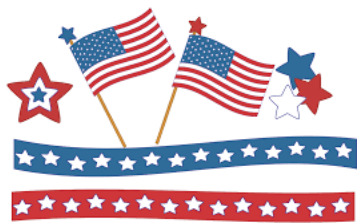
Lifeguards
Begin at the North & South Pools, weekends May 23 to June 7 and daily June 13 to August 25. Weekend Premise Access Control Personnel are scheduled Friday to Monday, May 22 to September 7



POOL RULES

Pool Hours 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
No Pool Parties or Private Lessons Allowed

1. Children under the age of 14 are not allowed in the pool gate without an adult or lifeguard. Children 14-17 years must wear a green swim tag to swim without an adult or lifeguard. Swim tags may be obtained in the Green Valley office and are for residents only.
2. Gates must always be kept closed and locked.
3. No more than 4 guests per Green Valley adult resident. No pool parties or large groups allowed.
4. Any damage to the pool or pool area will be the responsibility of the homeowner.
5. Showers are for rinsing off only. No soap or shampoo allowed.
6. No alcohol, smoking, illegal drugs, glass or breakable containers allowed. Barbecues must be outside the gated deck area.
7. While on duty, the lifeguards are the designated authority. Anyone violating pool rules will be asked to leave. Parents are responsible for their children/guests, regardless if there is a lifeguard on duty. Lifeguards will conduct a mandatory 5-minute safety break each hour. All individuals must exit the pool at that time. No exceptions.
8. To assist in the safety of all children, an adult must stay within 5' of small children in the pool at all times. An adult must be within 10' of any child that is not able to swim across the pool.
9. All children under the age of 4 (toilet trained or not) must wear a swim diaper or tight fitting plastic pants.
10. No toys or flotation devices allowed. Only those used to assist in swimming safely are permitted.
11. Any person having an obvious communicable disease, skin eruption, cut, sore or lesion, eye, ear, nose or throat infection, is not permitted from using the pool.
12. In the event of thunder or lightning, the pool will be closed immediately. It will reopen 30 minutes after the last incident.
13. No running, horseplay or pushing of others in the pool. Abusive/foul language or lewd conduct is prohibited.
14. No bicycles or skateboards allowed in the pool deck area.
15. In accordance with Health Department regulations, no pets are allowed in the pool area.
16. Proper swimming attire is required.
17. All persons swim at their own risk and should not swim alone when no lifeguard is on duty.
18. The Adult Pool is for those 21 years of age and older only. No infants or children.

Back Flow Device Replaced in Adult Clubhouse Parking Lot

The back flow was leaking into the bushes in the parking lot of the Adult Clubhouse. We didn't realize that it was slowly leaking until the planter was saturated with water.

The original back flow device (top picture) was replaced with a new one on a concrete pad with a locking metal cage enclosure.

The asphalt will be repaired around it, with the addition of two traffic bollard to prevent someone from backing into it.

A back flow device is used to stop reclaimed water from entering into the potable water lines. They are tested annually to make sure they are not leaking and has the necessary pressure to function correctly.

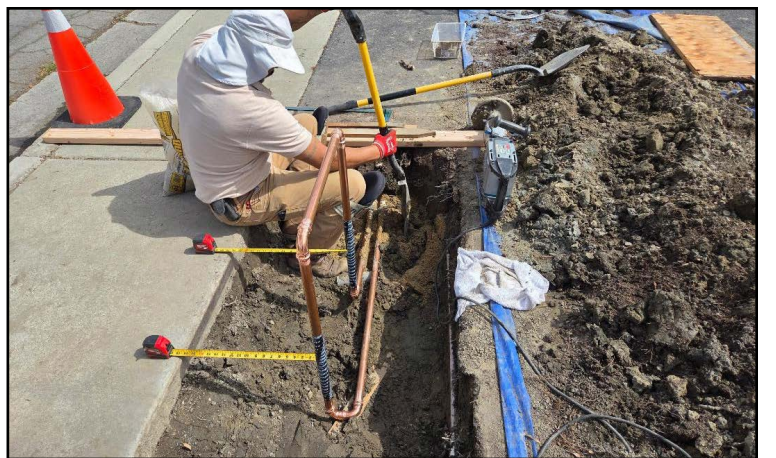
